**Method**

Make a tea infusion with hot distilled water using the herb white tea and let cool down to 100F/40oC. Sprinkle the gum into the tea decoction and mix well until the gum is dissolved. Add EDTA and mix again. Add phase B one by one into a glass beaker and heat to 150F/65C to melt the peg-150 distearate. Combine phase A with phase B and stir gently. Add phase C to phase A/B and stir again until it is a homogeneous solution.

**Properties**

Mild, herbal shower gel with white tea fragrance.
