Procedure

1. Combine phase A in a heat-resistant beaker. Heat gently to help the Magnesium Aluminum Silicate hydrate and thicken the water. Remove from heat once thickened. 2. Add phase B ingredients in order, stirring well after each addition. 3. Check pH after all of phase B is incorporated. *Add triethanolamine drop wise only in the event the pH isn't at least 4, stirring well and checking pH often. 4. Add phase C ingredients in order, stirring gently in between each so to prevent foaming/bubbles. Vitamin A needs to be melted before adding with a pipette.

Properties

This AHA clay mask helps brighten the skin due to glycolic acid and deep-cleans the pores with kaolin. Vitamin A reduces the look of fine lines and wrinkles while Provitamin B5 and glycerin hydrates and gives your skin a beautiful, healthy glow.
