

Tripeptide-5

Specification Sheet

Description: Highly bioactive, deeply skin penetrating peptide (palmitoyl tripeptide-5). Has been found in-vitro studies to activate tissue growth factor (TGF-beta). TGF-beta is known to stimulate collagen synthesis in the skin. The peptide content is 900-1300 ppm (approximately 1g peptide/1kg solution). Dissolved in glycerin & water.

Composition: Glycerin, Water, Palmitoyl Tripeptide-5

Appearance: Clear liquid, no odor

Benefits:

- In-vitro tests showed that tripeptide has better collagen building capacity than TGF-beta.
- Has been found to improve significantly the appearance of any type of wrinkles.
- Has good skin firming and moisturizing properties.
- May be able to reduce appearance of stretch marks. In clinical study with 60 volunteers a significant reduction of the appearance of wrinkles was shown after use of 84 days.
- Could be used as alternate method to collagen injections used in lip products.

Use: Add as is at the end of formulas. Typical use level: 1 - 3%. For external use only.

Applications: Anti-aging & anti-wrinkle products, pre/after sun lotions, hydrating skin care treatments, lip products, eye wrinkle treatment.

Solubility: Water-soluble

Preservation: Preservative-free

Storage: Store refrigerated (4-8°C / 39-46°F)
