

Natural Lip Balm Base

Specification Sheet

Contents: Ricinus Communis (Castor) Seed Oil, Cetyl Stearyl Alcohol, Olea Europaea (Olive) Fruit Oil, Beeswax, Hydrogenated Castor Oil, Glycine Soja (Soybean) Lipids, Lauryl Laurate, Copernicia Cerifera (Carnauba) Wax, Euphorbia Cerifera (Candelilla) Wax, Vitamin E Tocopherol. 3.5oz/100g of the base makes about 13-18 lip balms.

Appearance: Yellowish solid paste, faint odor.

Properties: Natural lip balm base with natural waxes and plant oils. The finished balm has excellent protecting and moisturizing properties.

Applications: For making lip balms solid lip glosses, can also be used at about 2-5% in lotions and creams to act as an emollient and stabilizer, for the dry skin. Shelf life ~9-12 months when protected from light and stored in the refrigerator.
