Goldenseal Extract

Description: Goldenseal root also known as yellow root or Indian turmeric. Contains 20% extract dissolved in water and glycerin.

CAS: 56-81-5, 7732-18-5, 84603-60-1

INCI Name: Glycerin, Water, Hydrastis Canadensis (Goldenseal) Extract

Composition: Glycerin, Water, Hydrastis Canadensis (Goldenseal) Extract, Phenoxyethanol

Appearance: Light to medium amber liquid, characteristic odor.

Benefits:

- Contains berberine that has been found to have cleansing properties and be useful in products for blemished and irritated skin.
- Useful for skin irritations making it a good ingredient for face cleansers, products for the sensitive skin, after-sun and bath products, and soothing lotions.

Use: Add to formulas to the water phase. Typical use level: 3-5%. For external use only.

Applications: Anti-aging formulas, sun care and after-sun care products, makeup-up, and hair care products.

Solubility: Water-soluble


Preservation: Phenoxyethanol

Storage: Store in a closed container at a dry place at room temperature.

Country of Origin: USA

Raw material source: Hydrastis Canadensis (Goldenseal), glycerin made of naturally derived oils

Manufacture: Prepared via a cold process to avoid potential loss of effectiveness heat processing can have. Created from naturally grown materials which are extracted first with a specified eluant to yield a concentrate. This concentrate is then dissolved in glycerin and water at a concentration of 20% concentrate and 80% diluents.
